Call for Scholarship Application

Background information

The Next Generation Leadership Programme for Kenya wishes to announce that it is accepting scholarship applications for the 2022/2023 academic year. The Programme was established to contribute to building the capacity of the Church by developing servant leaders who would contribute to developing leadership within Congregations and communities and the apostolic works of the Church. The Programme seeks to achieve this goal by providing eligible sisters, brothers, priests and lay persons working with and for the Church with access to higher education and leadership training. Preference is given to women religious and local congregations.

Eligibility Requirements

- Catholic Religious sisters, brothers and priests who can demonstrate leadership traits and potential may be nominated by their congregational / diocesan superior.
- Lay persons may be nominated by a Catholic institution (where they work) if they meet the following requirements: (1) evidence of a full-time employment with the nominating institution for at least three consecutive years and (2) holds a leadership position in the nominated organization.
- Specific levels of Study:
 1. Certificate: Limited to religious sisters and brothers only
 2. Diploma: Limited to religious sisters and brothers only
 3. Bachelor's Degree: Open to Priests, religious sisters, religious brothers and lay;

Fields of study

4. Master's Degree: Open to Priests, religious sisters, religious brothers and lay. However applicants who benefited from NGLP scholarship for their bachelors must have worked for a minimum of two years.

Note: Nominating organization may submit a maximum of two applications ONLY annually.

Limited to those that supports:

1. Education

Scholarships will be available to students enrolling in the Faculty of Education of qualifying institutions. Available courses may include: Education, Education Management and Development, Education Management and Planning, Education Science, Science in Education, Psychology and Counselling, and related courses.

2. Building just societies

Scholarships will be available to students enrolling in the Faculty of Law, Departments/Faculty of Philosophy, Religious Studies, Gender and Development, Community Development, Justice and peace. Available courses may include Law, Social Work, Philosophy, Peace Studies and International Relations, and related courses

3. Effective congregational/Church management and leadership

Scholarships will be available to students enrolling in the Faculty of Business of qualifying institutions. Available courses may include economics, Business Management, Human Resources Management, Finance, Corporate Management, Business Administration, accountancy and related courses.

4. Health

Scholarships will be available to students studying Bachelor of Nursing, Medical Lab Technician courses, Physiotherapy and Occupational therapy courses. Please note that lower qualifications in Nursing are not supported by the scholarship programme.

- Scholarships are given to students studying in Kenya and have also been living and serving in Kenya for the two consecutive years prior to the study period for which the scholarship is sort.
- Only students who are starting a course of study are eligible; a student in an on-going course of study is not allowed to apply for a scholarship.
- The total number of scholarships awarded annually depends on the availability of funds.
- There will be no age restriction; however, the student should show that he or she will be able to provide services and leadership comparable to the investment made.

Qualifying institutions of study

- An applicant who is not accepted on his or her first application is not barred from submitting an application in a subsequent year. However, if an applicant is not successful after three submissions, he or she will no longer be eligible.
- A student is not eligible to receive a tuition scholarship if he or she is a recipient of another tuition scholarship for the same course of study.
